REGISTRATION INFORMATION

All classes offered are listed in the following pages. Each listing includes a project photo, skill level, prerequisites, class and kit fees, techniques, description, and materials not included in the kit.

Notes:

- You do not need to be a Rocky Mountain Bead Society member to attend the Bazaar or take classes. However, members do not pay the \$15 Registration Fee for classes taken at the Bazaar, which is 50% of the annual membership fee! This fee is per student not per class and is does not include admission into the show.
- Some classes have age limits and/or prerequisites; please check class information online prior to registration.
- Classes with less than the minimum number of students as of April 13th, will be cancelled and a full refund issued.

All classes have both a class fee and a kit fee. The class fee will be paid during the online registration process. The kit fee is paid directly to the instructor during class. An ATM is available near the registration desks in the front of the Mart.

Class descriptions specify a level of experience necessary to successfully keep up with the class and complete the project. To ensure both student and instructor satisfaction, please read the following descriptions carefully to determine if your skill set matches the class requirements prior to registering for a class. Experience levels are listed after the class number starting on page 8.

If you are not comfortable with a specific stitch used, check out our Beading for Rookies classes on page 22.

- All Levels (AL): No experience needed.
- Advanced Beginner (AB): Has experience in similar types of work.
- Intermediate (IN): Has prior experience and is ready to learn variations.
- Advanced (AV): Has completed several projects and is ready for a challenge.

Class descriptions also include a detailed list of materials and tools that students need to bring to the classroom. Generally, students bring the following: a bead mat, needles, thread, scissors, pliers, cutters, a task light, and extension cord (if available).

Food is available in the rear of the Mart, including a coffee cart.

Parking is free at the Mart; valet parking is not available. Motorized carts are not available to rent at the Mart.

Arrive 30 minutes prior to the start of your class to allow adequate time for check-in, locating your classroom, and settling in. You will only need to check-in once, regardless of how many classes you are taking.

CLASS FEE: \$100.00
TECHNIQUE: Mold Making, casting, coloring using alcohol inks and gilders paste and finishing.
DESCRIPTION: Students will explore mold making, casting, and finishing pieces using the amazing Paper clay. The techniques used are the same ones that Gail uses for metal clay, resin, polymer and paper.
ADDITIONAL MATERIALS NEEDED: Objects for molding.

TECHNIQUE: Right Angle Weave
DESCRIPTION: Combine One-beads and O-beads in this unique design to create the three strand One-O-One Bracelet. Worked in the designer's very simple adaptation of right-angle weave (RAW), three individual strands are stitched (two strands using One-beads and one strand using O-beads). Complete step-by-step instructions will guide students as they make this dramatic bracelet.
ADDITIONAL MATERIALS NEEDED: Scissors, beading mat, task lamp and magnification (if needed).

Students will be challenged to put their creativity to action while continuing to fine tune your skills. Pre-requisite, must have soldering experience and wire working experience.
ADDITIONAL MATERIALS NEEDED: Magnifying glasses (MUST), fine tweezers, flush cutters (ultra preferred), fine tip round nose pliers, flat nose pliers, chain nose pliers, awl (fine), needle files

TECHNIQUE: Metalsmithing
DESCRIPTION: Attach Rings 2 Rings in a random pattern to create a truly one-of-a-kind cuff! Use of positive/negative space as a design element, plus the economy provided by the pre-made jump rings, allows students to create larger pieces without the traditional limitations of cost and weight.
ADDITIONAL MATERIALS NEEDED: Butane torch, butane, solder board, cookie sheet, rind mandrel, rawhide mallet, and pair of chain nose pliers.

This graceful tubular netting necklace is punctuated with a compelling cascading focal pendant using luminescent suede-gold 6 mm round beads and seed beads. Detailed step by step instructions will guide students as they make this graceful necklace.
ADDITIONAL MATERIALS NEEDED: Scissors, beading mat, task lamp and magnification (if needed).

CLAUDIA NECKLACE

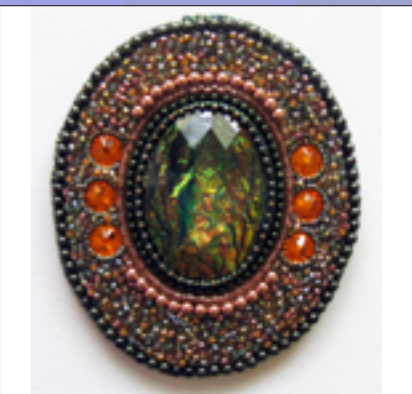

Participants will learn several stitches for the background and edging as well as the bezel. An alternate color of Arctic Ice in soft blues and white will be available.
ADDITIONAL MATERIALS NEEDED: #4 Fireline, or OneG, beading needles, E6000 glue, glue stick, beading mat, scissors, and task lamp.

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS NEEDED: #11 or #12 beading needles, 6lb Fireline bead mat, scissors, pen or pencil, and if needed a lamp and or magnifiers.

PINCH ME BRACELET

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate PREREQUISITES: Must know peyote stitch fluently

TECHNIQUE: Stitching similar to triangle weave.

DESCRIPTION: This bead is based on the classic dodecahedron shape and is made with a technique somewhat like triangle weave that is adapted to use with two-hole beads such as lentils, two-hole triangles and others.

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS NEEDED: Size 10 beading needles, Fireline 6 lb. smoke, Microcrystalline wax* disposable lighter*, Bead mat and light (optional). (*these items will be available for use during class)

TECHNIQUE: Metalsmithing

DESCRIPTION: Foldforming without fire! Learn some basic foldforming techniques while creating a beautiful bracelet focal using embossed, pre-patinated copper sheet. Following this, you'll learn how to embellish your creation using simple wire-wrapping techniques. You'll then rivet your focal onto a leather band and complete your bracelet.

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS NEEDED: Bench block, rivet setter, hammer, chain nose pliers, round nose pliers, metal shears, flush cutters. Some tools will be available for student use.

FOLDFORMED LEATHER CUFF

DESCRIPTION: Learn to etch copper sheet, including several methods of applying resist. After the etching is complete, you'll learn how to cut a bracelet blank from the etched copper and apply patina. Following this, you'll learn different ways to set a stone or focal bead on the bracelet and then finish and forge your cuff bracelet.

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS NEEDED: Dremel, metal shears, metal punch, chain nose pliers, round nose pliers, bracelet mandrel, hammer. Some tools will also be available for student use.

Description Take enamels to new heights with separation enamel. Through a series of layers and firing students will learn to transform copper and transparent enamels. (A variety of enamel colors will be provided to share.)

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS NEEDED: Chain nose pliers, #2 paint brush (fine tip), 5 pages of any magazine (of any kind), flat nose pliers, side cutters (flush preferred), magnifying glasses and Ott light as needed.

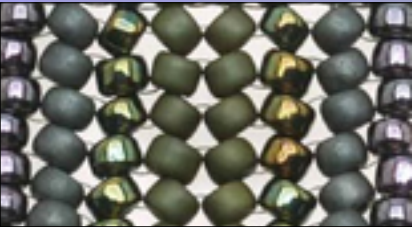
