We will have ten 6' round tables available to members who would like to sell at the De-Stash. Sign up for a table on the RMBS website when it goes live on Tuesday, September 28. Tables are \$10 each. If you would like only a half table, partner with another member who would love to share with you. Members are responsible for handling their own sales. Please plan to bring adequate change for purchases.
