AUGUST MEETING (8/2) - ANIMAL KINGDOM MINI CHALLENGE

2025 PROGRAMS SCHEDULE

Shona Bevan, a London-based bead designer, will be teaching workshops by Zoom on August 9 and 10. Members have the option to join as a group and Zoom at the Lowry Conference Center or can Zoom from home. These will be two full-day workshops. Registration has closed and Shona has shipped kits to participants so they will have them in time for the Zoom classes. You should be receiving your kit(s) in the very near future! **PLEASE NOTE: For Shona's Serpentine Pendant, she recommends that students should be very familiar with CRAW.** If you have registered for this class and feel you need a refresher on CRAW or more instruction, we will have an opportunity for members to learn CRAW at the August meeting. We will also have members in attendance at the workshop that will be able to help you if you have any problems or questions.

If you were lucky enough to take Tammi Williams' Kitty Cat Ornament class at the Sampler, Tammi will be teaching an "owl" ornament class following the regular meeting on Saturday, September 6 from 1:00-4:30 p.m. These owl ornaments are about

2" in diameter. If you are nervous about polymer clay because you think it's a long process, Tammi does ALL the prep work for you. She has each kit set up with every single piece of clay, pre-cut into correct colors and sizes. You just have to knead them into the right shape and apply. Easy, peasy! This project would be adorable holiday gifts for anyone who loves whimsical owls! Registration for Tammi's class will open on Monday, August 11 at 7:00 a.m and close on Saturday, August 30. Class fee will be \$45 and includes supplies.



For anyone excited to learn more about polymer clay, we will have a workshop with Randee Ketzel Saturday, October 11, 2025, on making Faux Cinnabar. Faux Cinnabar is an accessible sculpting technique that can be applied to a variety of



colors—and requires very little in the way of supplies. Even newbies produce astounding results. Randee is a polymer clay artist from Austin, Texas, and has coauthored a book with Kim Schlinke titled *Polymer Clay Gemstones: The Art of Deception*. This will be a hybrid session with Randee being present in person and some students participating through Zoom. Registration for Randee's class opened on July 13 for members only through August 1, with registration for both members and non-members closing on August 31. Class fee will be \$50 for members and \$70 for non-members. Registrants will get a supply list to fill on their own or, for those new to polymer and without a clay stuff stash, you can purchase a kit (\$15) that includes consumable supplies and the use of tools at the in-person class.

When suspended from a slim necklace this striking design makes the perfect classic pendant to wear anytime. Made with smaller beads, the scaled-down version makes stunning earrings that twist delightfully while you wear them.

This project is suitable for intermediate/advanced level beaders who have very strong CRAW skills.

Skill Level: Intermediate to advanced.

Prerequisites: Students should be very familiar with CRAW.

Kits are mandatory and will be purchased from Shona closer to the class date.

Bonbon Necklace

Almost sweet enough to eat, the Bonbon necklace is fun to make and easy to wear. Two sizes of lightweight cotton pearls are captured with sleek right angle weave (RAW) bezels and linked together with peyote stitched rings to make a relaxed long necklace.

This project is suitable for all levels of beader who have experience of RAW and peyote stitch.

Skill Level: Intermediate

Kits are mandatory and will be ordered from Shona closer to the class date.
